

WEEKLY VOLUNTEER POSITIONS

Food Prep/Kitchen Help:

You will assist the Cooks with basic food prep (salads, juice, and vegetables), serving and cleaning. You will be assigned to one of the following 6 hour shifts: 7am - 1pm or 2pm - 8pm. This will give you the remainder of the day to be involved in the camp program if you like, or you can just enjoy sitting and watching. You must be at least 16 years old and have basic meal preparation experience.

Dish Crew: (August 19-25 only)

You will be responsible for the set up and clean up of all camp meals. The number of hours you are in the kitchen varies depending on your speed and the amount of dishes to clean. It is our goal to limit your work time to 6-7 hours so that you have time to be involved in the camp program. You must be 17 years of age or older to be on the dish crew.

Speaker:

You are responsible to prepare five 5 min. staff devotions, 5 morning and 6 evening chapel sessions. The speaker plays a vital role in presenting the truths of the gospel and allowing the staff to follow up on those truths throughout the day. You must have prior experience working with and speaking to the specific age group.

Work Crew:

You will be assisting the caretaker by keeping the camp facilities and grounds clean and safe. Usually your tasks take about 6-7 hours each day, with opportunity the rest of the time to be involved in the camp program if you like. You must be at least 15 years old.
